Dr. Knight welcomed the members to the meeting and gave a brief overview of the year so far.

Presidents Report

Patricia Richmond greeted members, and began her President's report. She gave an overview of last year's PTSA work. We raised \$14,423.33 through the enrichment fund and the GA Gives Fundraiser. She gave several examples of what this money funded for DSA.

Patricia reported that this year the DSA PTSA has 231 members, which is 81 members less than last year, but isn't too surprising since we no longer have an 8th grade. \$10,000 is our goal for raising money for this year's enrichment fund, we are currently at \$6,305.

She also reminded the memberships that we are still looking for 2 Reflections co-chairs. This year's Reflections theme is "I will Change the World By..."

Lindsey Lingenfelter made motion was made to accept the minutes from the August general membership meeting, Lee Ann Else seconded and it was unanimously passed.

Siobhan Whitlock made a motion to accept the by-laws as written for this school year, Lindsey Lingenfelter seconded and the motion was unanimously passed.

Financial Report

Siobhan Whitlock began her financial presentation, she went over the most recent PTA Audit, which we successfully completed. She then went over the 2020-2021 budget.

Siobhan made a motion to accept the finance reports as is for the 2020-2021 school year, Lee Ann seconded and it was unanimously approved.

Siobhan went over the 2021-2022 budget - she presented a balanced budget.

Siobhan moved to approve the current budget for the 2021-2022 school year, Patricia seconded it and it was unanimously approved.

Siobhan reported that the bank balance is \$17,340.96. She will submit the audit September 30, 2021.
